Robed Choir



The robed choir sings twice a month at the communion services on second and fourth Sundays, and at the evening services on the first (communion) and third (evensong) Sundays. They rehearse on Thursday evenings from 7pm to 8:30pm and are always keen to welcome new members. Aside from hymns and the settings of the particular service, the choir also sings an anthem at each service. Five times a year there is a full choral evensong, cathedral style, with extra singers and a conductor. There are occasional visits to cathedrals to sing evensong.
